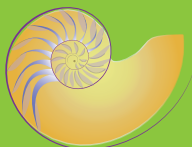

New Board Member • Catherine Hambley, PhD

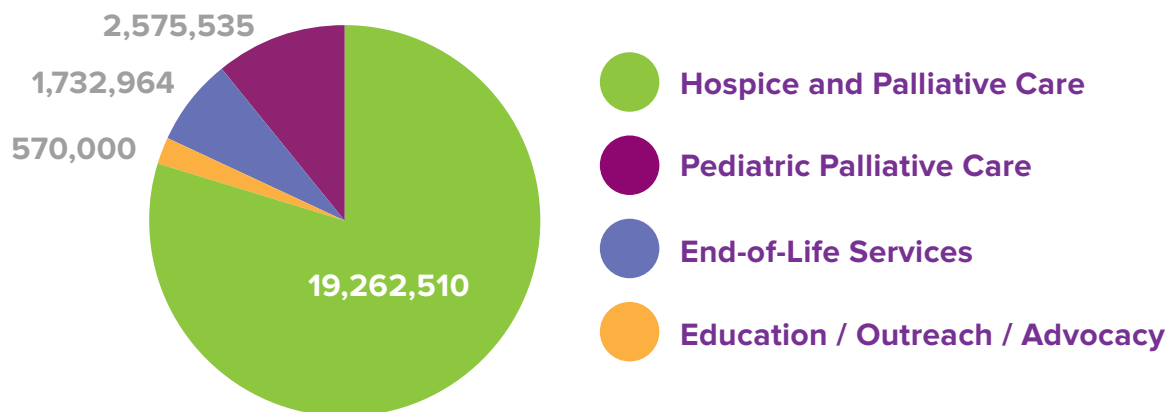

DICK AND MARIA FETHERSTONHAUGH

Their name can be hard to master*, however the Fetherstonhaughs are very easy to admire. Dick and Maria have been married for 67 years, have lived in 15 different cities across the US, and found their way back home to California some 30 years ago, when Dick retired from Pennzoil. Both native Californians, they know the value of working your way up, turning risks into opportunity, and making commitments to causes that resonate in their hearts. With friends around the country, a daughter, 3 granddaughters, and 2 great-granddaughters who bring daily joy to their lives, they consider themselves blessed. Their gratitude and kindness shine through in their daily actions.

It was the Friends of Hospice board, in full swing about 25 years ago, that brought Dick and Maria together with like-minded advocates for compassionate end-of-life care. It was the beginning of a movement, a time of learning about hospice, and encouraging other people to get involved. Over the years, Dick and Maria experienced their own losses, often supported by hospice. We visited with Dick and Maria at their home to talk about their long-standing generosity to Hospice Giving Foundation.

Smiling warmly, Dick talked about a friend who was a lover of good brandy. In this man's final days, Dick, Maria, and other close friends paid him a visit at Westland House, breaking a few nursing home rules along the way. Brandy snifters in hand, they toasted the good times they had shared and the wonderful people who graced their lives. Dick believes his friend died in a way that was living life fully until the end. It's a memory he cherishes.

Each year, Dick and Maria look forward to sharing a meal with other donors and listening to the speakers at Hospice Giving Foundation's annual Donor Gratitude Luncheon. They appreciate the chance to hear other people's perspectives and insights on end-of-life care. Maria is drawn to the education the Foundation offers and hopes that more people will partake and understand how much Hospice Giving Foundation does for our community. Dick is partial to the 'giving' part!

Our conversation coming to a close, we drifted to their name and its origin. While primarily of Irish descent, there seems to be a smattering of royal English blood. In traditional Irish fashion, they shared stories, laughed, and made us feel very welcome in their home. We left feeling that Dick and Maria are royalty—if not in their formal heritage, certainly to us at Hospice Giving Foundation. And for that, we are deeply grateful.

Hospice Giving Foundation Grants enable local agencies to:

- Hire exceptional teams: doctors, nurses, social workers, therapists, clergy, and home health care aides who provide care to both the patient and the family
- Provide responsive and consistent pain management
- Provide in-home nursing care, medical supplies, and equipment
- Stand beside family members to help them cope with the illness and understand the dying process
- Provide spiritual support and culturally-sensitive care to families
- Offer respite care, so that the family caregivers receive much-needed rest

Hospice care has been providing patients with compassionate care at the end-of-life since the 1960s. Focused on pain management and the emotional and physical needs of people in the last six months of life, this care brings relief and a sense of dignity to patients and their families. Hospice care includes spiritual support, the help of well-trained volunteers, and may include ancillary therapies such as massage, music, and art.

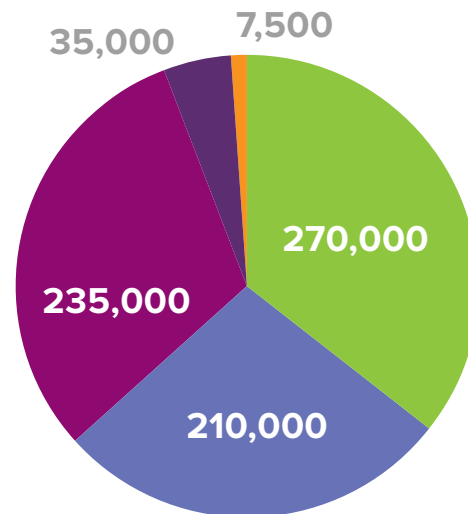

The grant enabled them to conduct a three-day series of events focusing on helping millennials deal with their grief and “to transform life after loss from an isolating experience into one marked by community support, candid conversation, and forward movement.” Carla Fernandez, one of the founders, was raised in Monterey and is a Stevenson graduate.

The Dinner Party • October 19

Under the cool, starlit sky of Carmel Valley at Gardener’s Ranch, 60 people of all ages gathered to share a meal and talk about life after loss at The Dinner Party. With delectable food by Paradise Catering, the gathering was designed for guests to experience what happens at The Dinner Party events, which are held across the country and gaining in popularity. Conversations at tables were facilitated by The Dinner Party founders Lennon Flowers and Carla Fernandez, and friends.

Gratitude Luncheon • October 20

Hospice Giving Foundation’s annual invitation-only luncheon to thank and inform loyal donors took place on October 20th at the Inn at Spanish Bay. Over 120 donors and volunteers attended. Dan Green of KSBW-TV led this year’s panel discussion and Q&A on “Life After Loss: From Grieving to Living Well.” The Dinner Party founders, joined by David Leonard,

Executive Director of the New Hope Grief Support Community, shared their stories and insights on helping millennials cope with grief.

Life After Loss Workshop: Creating Spaces for Grieving Millennials • October 21

This workshop for local professionals focused on understanding what 20- and 30-somethings look for while navigating life after loss. Sharing data collected from thousands of Dinner Party events, workshop presenters explored principles and guidelines for creating peer-to-peer spaces for grieving millennials. Hosted at the lovely Tonkin House of Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, registered nurses, chaplains, social workers, and therapists, came together to learn, and develop, skills to best support grieving millennials.

Palliative Care

2016 Grants Awarded to Adult Palliative Care:

\$210,000

Since its inception, Hospice Giving Foundation has contributed over \$2.2M to support palliative care in Monterey and San Benito Counties.

Hospice Giving Foundation Grants allow agencies to:

- Dedicate a trained physician to palliative-care service
- Provide spiritual care through a chaplain experienced in palliative care
- Pay for continuing education for palliative care physicians and healthcare professionals
- Make home nursing care visits and provide needed at-home medical equipment
- Conduct team planning sessions to coordinate care
- Conduct physician education to expand the integration of palliative care into traditional medical models.

As palliative care is better understood, it is helping many patients and their families in our community. Hospice Giving Foundation has been proud to fund several local providers and we are encouraged to see innovative approaches to this important element of end-of-life care. Once available only in hospitals, palliative care is being developed for outpatient settings and community-based programs. Palliative care focuses on the patient, not simply the disease. Seriously ill patients are cared for holistically, with a team that includes a physician, nurses, social workers, chaplains, and varied ancillary therapies. The goal is to improve the quality of life through symptom relief, pain and stress management, and strong family support. It is appropriate at any age and in any stage of a serious illness and can be provided along with curative treatment.

The Best Care Possible: Dr. Ira Byock



On June 16th clinicians, physicians, and faith leaders attended Hospice Giving Foundation's workshop "The Best Care Possible," featuring keynote speaker Dr. Ira Byock, one of the nation's foremost authorities in Palliative Care.

This workshop focused on the importance of collaborating and working together – across disciplines and cultures – to improve end-of-life care. It is part of Hospice Giving Foundation's commitment to convening the diverse members of the

community to best serve patients and their families.

Following Dr. Byock's presentation, participants joined together to discuss clinical cases, after which Dr. Byock joined local experts Dr. Marc Tunzi, Dr. Wendall Harry, Deacon Bill Ditewig, and Rev. Lawrence Robles for a panel discussion. Each shared their understanding about communication and cultural faith influences, to foster trust across disciplines to best support patients, and their families, facing end-of-life. Attendees also learned about the range of social and spiritual services, palliative care, and hospice services available locally.

A Career of Compassion

DR. MARK TUNZI



After 20 years at Natividad Medical Center, Dr. Marc Tunzi has gone to many funerals, had many conversations, and continues to help his patients answer the question, “What is a good death for you?”. A smart kid of Swiss-Italian parents, born at SVMH and raised in Spreckels, he describes going to med school as a series of “happy accidents.” Since science came easily to him, medical school seemed a natural fit. Dr. Tunzi trained at UC San Diego, which is most notably a research medical center. There he met his wife, Danielle, also a physician. Both Marc and Danielle however were drawn to what he calls “real medicine.” He sought out mentors interested in family medicine as well as leaders in the field of medical ethics. He and Danielle did their residency in Fresno, then made their way to Montana to an Indian Health clinic, and worked in an Idaho-based community migrant clinic, before returning to Salinas.

Community healthcare has defined his practice. As a family doctor, Dr. Tunzi deeply values patient relationships, and caring for the person, not

just treating the illness. Palliative care naturally complimented his practice model. Commonly accepted goals of medicine are curing illness, disease prevention, wellness, and prolonging life. But Dr. Tunzi remarks, “sometimes these goals conflict. You’re still living when you are dying; dying is still part of living.” He works with his patients asking them, “what is the best way to take care of you?”. Making big decisions together is part of the family’s culture. Respecting those traditions, he’ll often suggest to patients that the last big way they can take care of their family is to plan for what they want.

He recalls a case when he was in his second year of residency when he showed up at a patient’s funeral. The family was moved by his presence, but that experience stayed with Dr. Tunzi too. It’s rarely just the patient he cares for. It’s the family and loved ones who have to understand, think about what’s next, and say goodbye.

Dr. Tunzi believes our best teachers are our parents and grandparents. He’d love to see a broad campaign to get grandparents to talk about their plans, knowing the younger generation would learn from their wisdom. He hopes Hospice Giving Foundation can help make talking about end-of-life more normal so people aren’t so afraid. As a dedicated community physician, he also wants more services available to safety-net communities.

As a boy, he’d go to church with his mom. Often, they’d come home to hear his dad’s music filling the house. One of his favorite songs translated from Italian is “Everybody wants to go to heaven, nobody wants to die.” Dr. Marc Tunzi is there for his patients to help them live a dignified, respectful, life that includes a good death.

Outreach and Education

Hospice Giving Foundation offered these programs in 2016:

- Symposium on Palliative Care featuring Ira Byock, MD
- 1:1 or small group planning workshops with Shary Farr
- Monthly community education workshops
- Webinars on grief and loss
- Workshop on Coping with Grief at the Holidays
- Web based tools: Notes to My Family (English and Spanish), Financial planning and preparedness checklists

Over the years, Hospice Giving Foundation Grants have supported:

- One-to-one legal support for preparing wills and advance care directives
- Training videos for professionals to improve end-of-life services to indigenous language speaking families
- The “We Honor Vets” program in local hospice organizations
- End-of-Life Training and Planning Workshops: POLST (Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment) training for professionals, Advance Care Planning Workshops (addressing Five Wishes, POLST, advance care directives, Bioethical panel discussions for multi-disciplinary medical teams, and Financial planning and organizing one’s documents, wishes, and directives

Legal Services for Seniors

Since its inception, Hospice Giving Foundation has provided \$570,000 towards outreach and education.

Hospice Giving Foundation’s Outreach and Education includes in-house programs and grants to outside agencies. The focus is to inform people about resources and options for care, to assist individuals and families prepare for end-of-life, and to enhance professional development. The practical implications of knowledge and advanced planning include self-assurance, peace of mind, and less burdensome decision-making during times of crisis. Planning together adds dignity and comfort for all involved. Improved communication with family, friends, and medical providers results in better-quality care for patients and families. Understanding conversations can be hard to start and decisions can be complex; Hospice Giving Foundation offers tools, checklists, and workshops to assist the process.

Grief and Family Support Services

Hospice Giving Foundation Grants provide for:

- Individual grief therapy
- Anticipatory grief support
- Care for caregivers / respite care
- Grief therapy / support groups
- Expressive arts therapy
- Services for late-stage Alzheimer’s

Professional grief programs offer support to help people feel less alone, while also giving them the tools and encouragement they need to move forward in their lives. Although loss manifests differently in each person, talking about loved ones who are seriously ill, dying, or have already died, can offer great solace. After a loved one dies, thoughtful guidance, support from a professional, and sharing the experience of loss with others who have been through it, encourages healing. Hospice Giving Foundation awards grants for grief therapy and ongoing support for families and individuals to help them come to terms with life after a loss.

Since its inception, Hospice Giving Foundation has provided over \$1.7M for grief counseling, services for special populations, and a range of family support programs.

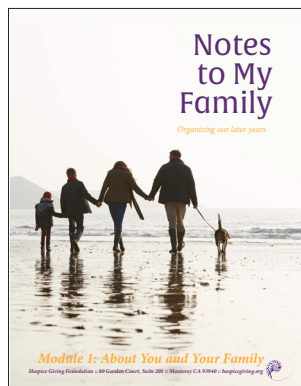

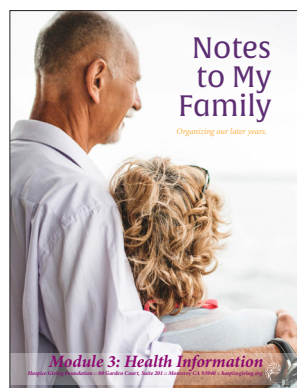

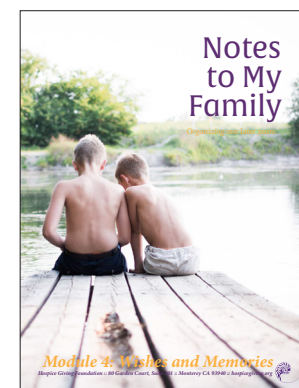

Opening Their Home, From Their Heart

The member-owners of Monterey Peninsula Country Club don't look for recognition, don't ask for fanfare, but graciously share their "home" with select charities. Hospice Giving Foundation has been one of them for the past decade. On his daily drive to work, Mike Bowhay, General Manager of MPCC for over 25 years, reflects on how graced we are to live in such a breathtaking part of the world. The people he encounters each day add to the beauty with generosity and open hearts.

Sympathetic to people not understanding hospice care if they've not traveled the journey, Monterey native Mike admits he didn't really understand at first either. He didn't know what difference it could make, but now he knows. He responds to questions about why MPCC supports Hospice Giving Foundation by asking "Have you not ever had anyone benefit from hospice care?" For his family, the hospice team not only helped his mother-in-law die peacefully with her pain and symptoms managed, they provided kind and nurturing support to his wife, Marcia, and their family. He says they made a huge difference for Marcia, and for that he is deeply grateful.

Mike Bowhay says he just woke up one day and realized hospitality was his industry. He traveled some, but he and Marcia made it back to Monterey in the beginning of the 1990s. Two weeks before he started at MPCC in 1991 their world expanded with the birth of their daughter Brooke. A natural talent, Brooke spent a lot of time learning about life on the stages of Forest Theater, Pac Rep, or with Dance Kids, while Mike and Marcia often volunteered backstage and sometimes behind those bright lights.

Anyone in hospitality knows it's long days and hard work. Mike knows that being home on the Monterey Peninsula, close to family, and working alongside the tremendous professional team and generous members of MPCC, rewards his hard work with meaningful relationships and a sense of community.



Palliative Care for Terminally Ill Children

Hospice Giving Foundation Grants provide for:

- In-home nursing care and multi-agency service coordination
- Grief and family therapy, and ongoing support
- Specialized medical equipment
- Transportation to medical appointments, usually at UC San Francisco or Lucille Packard Children's Hospital in Palo Alto
- Stipends for basic needs, groceries, and rent
- Expressive arts therapies
- Clinical training for staff

Hearing the words “children” and “end-of-life care” in the same sentence is heartbreaking. A child's life-threatening illness takes an average family and turns their world upside down. Finding the right medical treatment is only a part of the battle. Balancing the needs of the ill child and the rest of the family becomes incredibly complex and challenging. Through grants to three local agencies, Hospice Giving Foundation supports an all-encompassing approach to caring for the child and helping the family.

Palliative care for a child, often a lengthy course of treatment, includes curative therapies, pain management, in-home nursing, and comfort care. Extensive family support—a cornerstone of children's palliative care—includes grief and family therapy, as well as practical resources for costly medications, household necessities, and transportation.

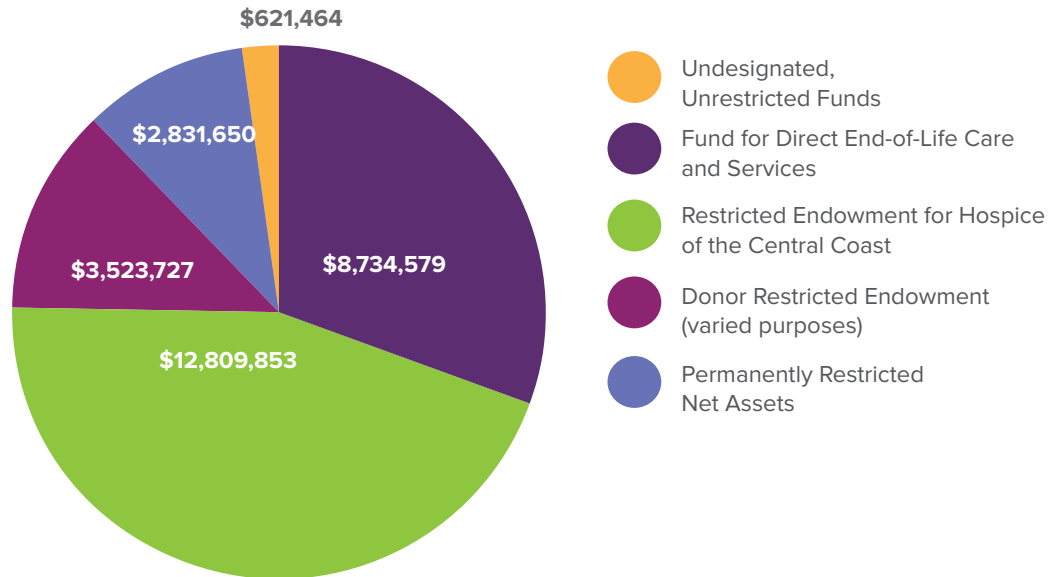

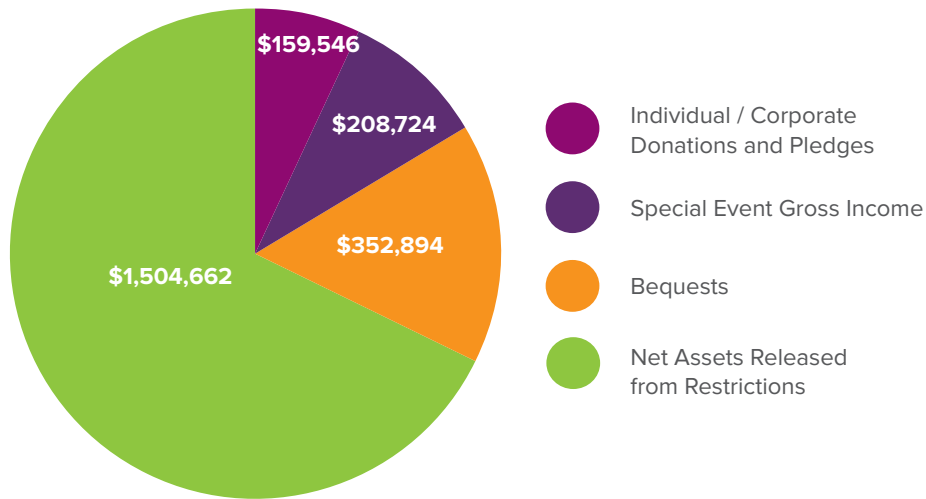

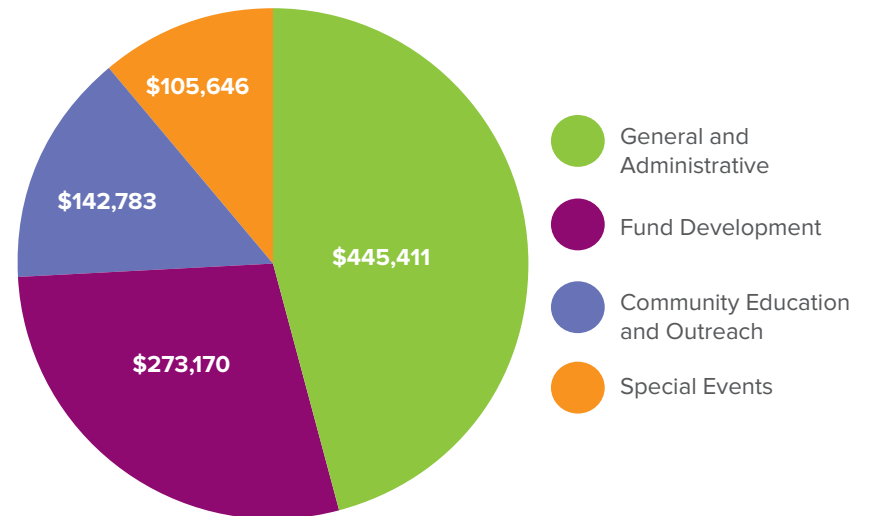
Net Assets as of June 30, 2016: \$28,521,273
