What is Palliative Care

Palliative care (pronounced pal-lee-uh-tiv) is specialized medical care for people living with a serious illness. Palliative care focuses on providing relief from the symptoms and stress of the illness. It's appropriate at any stage of a serious illness and the goal is to improve quality of life for both the patient and the family.

Palliative care is provided by a specially-trained team of doctors, nurses and other specialists, who work with patient's other doctors. Palliative care is based on medical and practical needs of the patient, not just the prognosis. The team works to support the patient and family and to help them understand the course of the illness.

How the palliative service can help?

- Major decision-making related to serious illness/frailty 
- Advance Care Planning

- Symptom management
- Psychosocial support

Some indications for referral

- Difficult-to-control symptoms
- Multiple hospitalizations
- Uncertainty with goals of care
- High stress from impact of disease
