Days for the Dead

October 30 to November 2

"Imagine a candle lighted dinner date complete with greetings, conversations and memories, music, dinner, drinks, flowers, and a farewell."

Decorations on the offerings vary from family to family, however, the presence of the four elements that give life, earth, wind, water, and fire persist.

Also included is the science of the five senses, sight, hearing, smell, taste, and touch.

Earth: Clay pots, and everything that is born from the earth.

Wind: Shredded paper, pendants, paper flowers, papier Mache figures, and plants.

► Water: Liquids, drinks, and plants.

Fire: Candles, fire, and copal.

Other objects:

- ▶ Photos of the deceased.
- A favorite dinner and drink (s).
- ▶ If they are deceased children, toys, objects, and favorite treats.
- ▶ Music, songs, dance, and lots of Marigolds.

Days for the Dead are aromas, flavors, rhythms, dance, tears, smiles, emotions, and feelings. They are infinite memories of living experiences. They are the slow moments that fill us with joy and pain. Days for the Dead, advise us that at the end of our journey in this world, life ceases and we become memories.
