A RAPID RESPONSE TO GRIEF

In early April 2021, the Board of Directors for Hospice Giving Foundation established a major grant initiative called **Heal Together**, to support the expansion of grief and bereavement services throughout Monterey County. In December 2021 the grant was awarded to Coastal Kids Home Care who established the Heal Together Hub as their one-stop center for referrals, information, and resources.

Hospice Giving Foundation pledged the first \$500,000 and set a goal to build the fund to \$1.5MM.

MONTEREY COUNTY PALLIATIVE CARE COLLABORATIVE

In 2018 Dr. John Hausdorff requested HG Foundation support his vision to bring together palliative care providers to strengthen services in our county. Since that time, HG Foundation has hosted and organized the monthly meetings focused on building a sense of community among providers dedicated to improving care. During 2021 members explored changes to the End-of-Life Option Act, models of inpatient palliative care, access to pain management medications during the opioid crisis, use of the POLST, and cultural factors in end-of-life experiences.

"The Monterey County Palliative Care Collaborative is a monthly forum for clinician-leaders in palliative and hospice care of Monterey and San Benito Counties. We seek to foster and facilitate communication and sharing of ideas, talents, skills and energy, with the aim of improving the coordination and delivery of palliative and hospice care services locally and aim to transcend institutional boundaries to achieve this common goal."

Under the direction of Erandi Garcia, the group meets monthly with a shared vision to advocate for accessible, equitable, and respectful end-of-life care for people in Latinx communities. Beyond monthly meetings, 'Juntos' hosts outreach events and addresses topics such as having the 'conversation', cultural influences around death, family systems and traditions, as well as how to improve support for in-home caregivers.



LA COLABORACIÓN DE CUIDADOS PALIATIVOS DEL CONDADO DE MONTEREY


